Volunteers and riders needed for CanAm 6: Sunday, August 14, 2011

In 2006 Mary Alice Tock was the prime mover in starting an event that has become an NFBC tradition—the CanAm Century Ride. She led the CanAm committee for two years before passing on the task to Mike and Brenda Fischer. Along with their committee, they tweaked the ride a little. The start was changed from LaSalle Park to the Frank Lloyd Boat House, which also became the venue for a popular pre-ride party. Rebecca Ribis and I became the CanAm committee leaders for the 2010 ride last year—and we will continue in that role for this year's ride.

CanAm 6 is set for **Sunday, August 14, 2011!**

While most features of the ride will remain the same—the Frank Lloyd Wright Boat House party and start location, the Saturday bicycle tour of Buffalo initiated by Rebecca in 2009, and the choices of three distances—this year's committee has been exploring some changes. The most substantial change would be the rerouting of the 100-mile ride to explore more of the Niagara peninsula in Canada.

There are, of course, changes in the committee itself. Liz Skelton, Moe Balling, and Gwen Macool have

headed food, publicity, and rest stop subcommittees in the past and are ready for a break. Terry Turski has joined the CanAm committee to help with publicity this year. Some of the multi-year stalwarts like Ian Currie, Brenda Fischer, and Bob Mahaney will continue to serve at least one more year as subcommittee leaders. Dennis Powell is going to continue as the CanAm registrar, and Mary Alice Tock will spearhead much of what happens on the Canadian side of the border. I expect that many others whom I haven't mentioned will continue to support the ride at rest stops, with set-up and clean-up, and doing the myriad other tasks that putting on such an event demands.

HOWEVER, we need YOU! If you are willing to take on a task, whether large or small, that will help to make our sixth CanAm a success, please volunteer. Call or e-mail Linc (linc43@roadrunner.com) or another member of the CanAm committee to see where you could be of use. But most of all save the date (and register early) so that you can help make the day a success by doing what you like to do anyway--RIDING.

nfbc@yahoogroups.com: updates and reminders

Last year was the inaugural run of our NFBC email list. The email list has been a means of conveying information about rides and club activities, as well as some cycling-pertinent (and impertinent) items. Overall the list has worked well in keeping us informed (and entertained).

We will continue with the Yahoo groups email list for the 2011 season with one minor change. When you receive an email from the list and wish to reply to the email, the address, by default, that will go in the "To" field of your reply will only be the original poster, **not the entire list**. For any replies you wish to go to the entire list, you will need to type in "nfbc@yahoogroups.com" in the "To" or "CC" fields. This will keep people from sending replies to the entire membership that they intend to send only to the original poster.

As a reminder, and for those not familiar with the yahoogroups list:

nfbc@yahoogroups.com is NOT a public list. It is open to NFBC members only. You do not need to have an account with Yahoo! to be on the email list. For those of you with Yahoo! accounts, once you are on the list, logging in will allow a view of the NFBC area on Yahoo! This is NOT publicly viewable.



How to make a post: From the email account you entered on your NFBC membership form, in the "To:" field of your email program, type nfbc@yahoogroups.com. Type in your message and send it. It will be distributed to the entire membership.

How to reply to a message on nfbc@yahoogroups.com: When you click on "Reply" in your email program, the "To" field will automatically have the original poster's email address filled in. If you wish to send this message to the entire NFBC membership, add nfbc@yahoogroups.com in the "CC" field.

Options for receiving email from nfbc@yahoogroups.com: You have options concerning how you receive emails from the nfbc group. By default, you will get an email whenever someone makes a post to the group. As an alternative, you can get your messages compiled in "digest" form, in one email per day; you may lose timeliness, but you reduce your email clutter. As a third option, you can elect to receive *only* posts made by moderators. The plus side of this option is that most of the emails you will see are official NFBC information, but the downside is that some moderators may make personal posts, and these might be difficult to distinguish from the important club information. Message posts are available on the Yahoo! web site. You can elect to view all the nfbc@yahoogroups.com messages there. Old messages will also be archived on the site. If you have a Yahoo email account you can choose and change your own options, but if not, you can ask a moderator to change them for you.



LIST GUIDELINES

Messages should pertain to NFBC activities, such as rides, NFBC parties or cycling-related topics of interest to club members. Please keep your posts on topic and brief.

Refrain from using profanity, vulgarities, or other language that may be offensive to other list members in your posts.

Be courteous to other list members. If you disagree with someone's post and want to say so on the list, exercise politeness in your reply.

When replying and quoting another sender's message, clip out everything of the other sender's message except what's pertinent to your reply. This will make it easier for all to read these messages.

This list is NOT to be used for any commercial purposes. A private seller may advertise a bike they want to sell, for instance, but a bicycle business should not advertise that they are having a sale on bikes this weekend on this list.

Do not send email attachments to the list.

FULLY UNDERSTAND that: (a) bicycling activities involve risks and dangers of serious bodily injury, including permanent disability, paralysis and death; (b) these risks and dangers may be caused by my own actions, or inactions, the actions or inactions of others participating in the activity, the condition in which the activity takes place, or the negligence of the releasees named below; (c) there may be other risks and social and economic losses whether known to me or not readily foreseeable at this time; and I fully accept and assume all such risks and all responsibility for losses, costs, and damages I incur as a result of my participation in this activity.

3. In the interest of safety on the road for members of the NFBC, all riders and guests must acknowledge having read and understood the "Duties of Riders of the NFBC" statement by signing it before participating in any NFBC-sponsored ride.

Duties of Riders of the NFBC By becoming a member of the NFBC, all riders represent they have the knowledge and skills necessary to minimize the risk of injury in the sport of cycling. Riders shall have the following additional duties to enable them to make informed decisions while participating in the sport of bicycling:

- Riders must obey New York State vehicle and traffic laws. Riders are governed by the same laws as motor vehicles. Riding in an NFBC group does not give riders the right to run stop signs or traffic signals.
- All riders must wear a Snell or ANSI approved bicycle helmet.
- Riders should not ride beyond their limits or their ability to cope with variations in road conditions (wetness, gravel, ice, snow, potholes, etc.).
- Riders must remain in constant control of speed and direction at all times so as to avoid contact with obstacles and with other riders.
- Riders should familiarize themselves with verbal and posted information before riding the route. The NFBC ride facilitators do not represent the route as free of hazards to bicyclists.
- Riders must not overtake another rider in such a manner as to cause contact with the rider being overtaken.
- Riders make certain there is adequate safe space between themselves and the rider in front.
- Riders should communicate with other riders by calling out and announcing the following:
 - "Car Back": warning riders in front of them that there is a car approaching from the rear and signaling to single up. It is important to pass this information along the line of riders
 - "Car Up": warning the group that a car is approaching from the front. It is important to pass the word back.
 - "Single Up": telling the group that riders need to be riding single file
 - "Car Left or Right": warning riders at intersections or other places that a car might enter the path
 - "Walker or Runner Up": warning riders there is someone on foot on the riders' side of the road.
 - "Tracks": warning riders about railroad tracks. Riders should cross at right angles to the rails.
 - "Road Kill": warning riders there is a dead animal in their path.
 - "Hole(s)": warning riders about dangerous breaks in the pavement. Sometimes riders may just point down to show that something is there instead of calling out the warning.
 - "Stopping or Slowing": warning riders of a change in speed. This may be done with a hand signal, but a call helps to avoid a problem.
 - "On Your Left or Right": warning riders that someone is passing. Riders should always pass on the left, but if they find themselves on the right, they should announce they are passing on the right.
