Team NFBC had 15 riders scheduled to participate in the Empire State Ride this year. Riders would have been riding 554 miles from NYC to Niagara Falls on July 26th through August 1st. As the ride could not go on as planned, riders were challenged to ride 500+ miles during the month of July. I know of several Team NFBC riders who decided that fighting cancer is much harder than riding 500 miles in a month, so they kicked it up a notch and doubled that riding over 1,000 miles for the month. Kudos to Joyce Warthling, Paul Rossi, Fred Marcheson, Jenny Boggio, Dave Dunkle and myself for the huge accomplishment! As a team, we raised over \$43,000. Top four fundraisers were yours truly, Michelle Lynn Bates, Fred Marcheson and JoAnn Blatner. Great job team!



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Summer of the RIDE



This year Team NFBC for the Ride for Roswell consisted of 19 members. Although the format of the ride was changed, it did not stop our fundraising efforts. As a team, we raised over \$12,000. The top fundraiser was Michele Ambor-Hutz, raising over \$3,800. Rick Hanes raised over \$2,000 and David Bowman, John Swaine and Rob McDonald all raised over \$1,000. Several members of team NFBC joined other NFBC members and Empire State Ride riders in a unofficial Ride for Roswell metric century held on June 28, 2020. With the help of several volunteers, we were able to pull together a metric century with two fully stocked rest stops. The weather was perfect, and it was a great day to ride. Several members also participated by doing their own rides or supported rides during the Summer of Ride.



Club Members also participated in the Summer of the Ride with various teams, raising funds for the fight against cancer. John Kozinski rode for the team Fighting Irish Fighting Cancer which raised \$36,000!
